- **Carpool and Vanpool Formation Assistance:** Tenants who are interested in carpooling or vanpooling may get a personalized matchlist of others who are interested. Every effort will be made to find the ideal match.
- **Carpool and Vanpool Reserved Parking:** Reserved Carpool and Vanpool parking will be available on P-2 of the parking garage. Please look for announcements on procedures for carpool and vanpool parking.

"Extreme Exposure" Coming to Annenberg

The Annenberg Space for Photography will present **SPACE FOR PHOTOGRAPHY** "Extreme Exposure," a group exhibit featuring arresting imagery from five unique talents in photography who work on the edge of wildlife, climate and environment.



These photographers have made careers of capturing some of our planet's most extreme environments, while dangling from a helicopter or immersed in alligator-infested waters; enduring freezing temperatures for months or braving an angry volcano. They share an intense passion and purpose and use their photos to protect places, species and landscapes they care about.

"Extreme Exposure" will showcase:

- Swamplands captured by Clyde Butcher using a bold interplay of shadow and light.
- Lush jungle photography by Michael Nichols that brings the audience nearly face-to-face with tigers and gorillas.
- Paul Nicklen's transfixing photos of the alien landscapes found in polar regions and the rare animals inhabiting these isolated environments.
- Donna and Stephen James O'Meara's vibrant photos of erupting volcanoes and dancing molten lava.

In addition to the print exhibit, digital film presentations will expand the visitor experience by sharing hundreds more images, as well as insights from photographers, on the Photography Space's high-resolution screens. Viewers will be immersed in breathtaking imagery, while gaining a perspective that only the photographers can provide. The exhibit's featured artists will recount the many adventures that provided their stunning photographs, their creative methods and what it takes to work in such exotic locations.

During the exhibit, the free IRIS Nights lecture series will continue to be offered inside the Photography Space on Thursday evenings, and will expand on the images and themes presented in the galleries. Additional programs related to the exhibit will include a themed group slideshow evening and photography workshops. Details and final schedules will be announced later this fall.

"Extreme Exposure" will be available for viewing October 23, 2010 through April 17, 2011.

Back-to-School Safety Tips



Children are back in school, and some parents may be breathing a sigh of relief after the long summer. But before you pack the kids up and rush them out the door, there are a few things to keep in mind regarding their wellbeing. Here are some tips to help ensure the safety of your little ones, as you send them off to tackle another school year.

Walking To And From School – Map out the route your children will take and know who lives along it. While you don't have to know every homeowner, it is important you research for any possible sexual predators that may live in the area. Also advise your children to stay on the preselected path and avoid areas where there aren't a lot of people around. Ensure your children know their address and phone number.

Riding A Bike Or Scooter – Make sure they know and obey the traffic laws and wear proper safety equipment.

If You Plan On Driving Your Children To School – Make sure you see them enter the school yard or building before you leave.

If Your Children Will Be Taking The Bus – Instruct them to arrive at the stop early, stay out of the street while waiting and always keep themselves visible to the bus driver.

Dealing With Bullies – Teach your children to stand tall, remain calm and walk away from difficult confrontations. If you suspect your children are being bullied, visit the school immediately and explain the situation to the principal.

Playground Safety – Check out the equipment your children will be playing on and report any potential hazards. Remove the drawstrings from around the neck of clothing; any drawstrings at the waist or bottom of a garment should be trimmed to no more than three inches long.

Children Need Strict Rules In Place If They Will Be Home Alone – Set a check-in time for them to call and let you know they made it home, and make sure they understand to keep the doors locked once they're inside. Additionally, you and your children should make plans beforehand for what they need to do in emergency situations, such as fires, accidents, earthquakes, etc.

Remaining Healthy And Drug/Alcohol-Free Can Be Challenging For Kids When Faced With Peer Pressure – Take this opportunity to speak to them about it. The Office of National Drug Control Policy has launched a campaign called Above the Influence to help you approach this topic with your children.
