## Central Plant at Century Plaza Towers is On-Line and Operational



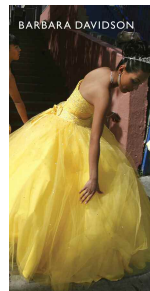
The 6,300 ton Central Plant specifically services Century Plaza Towers. The state of the art Central Plant with highly energy efficient chillers, boilers and cooling towers allows ownership and management to provide long term operating expense efficiencies to the tenants of the project.

Century Plaza Towers is in a unique position to avoid chilled water (HVAC) outages experienced by other buildings in Century City that are currently on the Century City central plant, which is owned and operated by a third party energy provider. The Central Plant at Century Plaza Towers will produce zero PM-10 & PM emissions, zero VOC emissions, ultra low NOx emissions and reduce the net environmental impact of antiquated equipment by 30%.

With approximately 60 images, the print exhibit will cover 2009 with views of youth culture, soldiers' stories, the continued economic crisis, environmental disasters, pop culture, Communist and Middle East conflict, animal extinction, U.S. healthcare, and more.

**THE YEAR's** digital exhibit will feature hundreds of additional winning images and will follow winning photojournalists 'behind the lens' in the field, such as – **Barbara Davidson** and **Brian L. The exhibit will kick off June 24 – 25, 2010 with the POYi Education & Awards program, a two-day event that includes presentations by the exhibited award-winning photojournalists.
